From the Stewardship Finance Committee:

We have been a busy committee and have met at least monthly, if not more, for the past months. Pastor Dane has a keen interest in finances and has been sharing his knowledge with us, it is appreciated!

As a committee, we met with each staff member and committee/work area chair to review their budget request for 2025. Kristen provided each presenter with historical expenditure data as well as to date expenditures to assist them in developing their requests for 2025. In November, the finance committee will finalize the 2025 budget with the goal of projected expenses being equal to anticipated giving.

You may have noticed that we did not have an annual stewardship campaign. With the unanticipated departure of Tom, LeNoir as an interim pastor and the arrival of Pastor Dane in September, the timing was not ideal. It is too close to one of the busiest seasons of the church to have a campaign now. We anticipate a campaign within the first 4-6 months of 2025.

What does that mean for you and Trinity? We do not think monthly expenses will decrease significantly, staff and committees will remain judicious in their spending. You will not be asked to complete a pledge card. We hope that this does not deter you from your continued faithful giving as we are getting closer to the end of 2024 and the beginning of 2025.
